The 2006 B&ECPL operating budget funds Sunday open hours at the Central, Audubon, North Collins and Orchard Park libraries.

*Sunday hours at the Clearfield (Amherst) Library are provided as a result of volunteer fund-raising efforts.

**The Town of Cheektowaga funds Sunday hours at the J.B.R. and Reinstein libraries.

SUNDAY HOURS FOOTNOTE: In 2005, Central, Audubon, J.B.R., Orchard Park and Reinstein were **not open** in January.

FOOTNOTES

2006

SYSTEM-WIDE: Several libraries reduced operating hours in 2006 due to budget cutbacks. **These reductions are in addition to service hour reductions that occurred in January 2005.** Fewer service hours affected circulation at many libraries.

Central: BS&T, Grosvenor & Children's are closed on Fridays (begun in Nov. 2005) for a reduction of 24 hrs. per week. In addition, BS&T has a later opening (also begun in Nov. 2005), 10 AM rather than 8:30, (Grosvenor & Children's instituted those opening hours in January 2005), for an additional reduction of 9 hrs. per week in BS&T.

City Branches: The eight remaining branches cumulatively are open 205 fewer hours per week than in 2005.

Alden (Ewell) Free: Open hours reduced by 3 hours per week.

Amherst Libraries: Increased open hours by 14 over 2005 due to additional funding provided by the Town of Amherst.

Aurora Town Lib: Open hours reduced by 14 hours per week, primarily due to closing of West Falls Library.

Boston Free Lib: Open hours reduced by 5 hours per week.

Cheektowaga Libs: Open hours reduced by 29 hours per week.

Collins Public: Open hours reduced by 5 hours per week.

Concord Library: Open hours reduced by 3 hours per week.

Eden Library: Open hours reduced by 5 hours per week.

Elma Public: Open hours reduced by 8 hours per week.

Hamburg Libraries: Open hours reduced by 23 hours per week.

Lackawanna Pub: Open hours reduced by 12 hours per week.

Lancaster Public: Open hours reduced by 4 hours per week.

Marilla Free: Operated for most of the day without electricity on 1/18/2006 due to a power outage.

North Collins Pub: Open hours reduced by 3 hours per week.

Tonawanda City: Open hours reduced by 6 hours per week.

Tonawanda Town: Open hours reduced by 57 hours per week.

2005

SYSTEM-WIDE: Many libraries reduced service hours beginning in January 2005 due to budget reductions. Refer to the January or December 2005 circulation reports for details on each library affected.
