2007*

* **City Branches & Central** A formula error impacting February 2007 and February 2008 year to date totals was found in February 2009. This error understated results for both years (actual activity was higher than previously reported). Incorrect year to date figures for Buffalo Branches and the Central Library were subsequently carried into 2008 calculations and comparison data. Spreadsheets have been retrospectively corrected as of April 2009.

Concord: Closed 2 hours (A.M.) on 2/6/2007 due to inclement weather.
Elma: Closed 1 hour early on 2/6/2007 due to inclement weather.
Lake Shore: Closed 2/5/2007 due to inclement weather.
Orchard Park: Closed Sunday, 2/4/2007, due to snowstorm and driving ban.

Youth Resource Center computers were added to all locations during Fall 2001. These computers do not require registration before use and are not tracked in these statistics. Therefore, juvenile computer use statistics are underreported.

2006

System-Wide: Many libraries reduced operating hours in 2006 due to budget cutbacks. The reductions are in addition to service hour reductions that occurred in January 2005. Fewer service hours affected circulation at many units.

Concord: Delayed opening on 2/17/2006 until noon due to inclement weather; lost 2 service hours.
