Come Learn about the history of trans men and transmasculine individuals in Western New York from 1900 to the present. We will talk about:


- The trans men who inhabited the saloons at the canal's edge at the turn of the 20th century.

- The evolving place of trans men in queer community spaces from the 1990s to the present and more!




