- Assists patrons at the Teen Services desk and other public service desks;
- Performs routine circulation and reserve functions, issues library cards;
- Maintains library records;
- Monitors public use of the Teen Space;
- Assists with programming for teens, e.g. crafting;
- Participates in payroll functions by preparing time sheets;
- Participates in special projects as assigned.
