## 175<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY GALA TO BE PRESENTED AT DOWNTOWN LIBRARY "A Rare Affair" Gala November 5 – Unique Location and Auction items

More than 450 people will gather on **Saturday, November 5** in the downtown Central Library at Lafayette Square to celebrate and raise funds for the Buffalo & Erie County Public Library System. *A Rare Affair Gala* is being held to honor the 175-year legacy of free public library services in Erie County.

Judi and Stanford Lipsey are the Gala's Honorary Chairs; Anne and Dan Leary are planning Co-Chairs of the event which highlights the many rare treasures from the Library's collections. Featured one-of-a-kind items to be auctioned at the Gala include a rocking chair in which author Mark Twain was photographed in 1906; a fine art framed reproduction of a 1776 letter written by George Washington, and a fine art reproduction of one of the earliest published maps of the world (1475).

Upon arrival guests will be greeted with the jazzy sounds of the Colored Musicians Club. Champagne and hors d'oeuvres followed by a full course sit-down dinner will be catered by Rich's Catering. Forty extraordinary items will make up the silent and live auctions before the evening winds down to the rollicking live music of Buffalo's own Nickel City Pimp Choir.
