## **eReader on Your Wish List?**

### ***Free Downloads 24/7 from the Buffalo & Erie County Public Library System***

With the growing popularity of eReaders (*the Nook, Kindle, iPad, iPhone, iTouch, Sony reader, etc.*) the Buffalo & Erie County Public Library System reminds you that you can download books, music and video anytime, day or night, through the Library System website, <http://www.BuffaloLib.org>. Best of all, downloads are free with your free library card.

“We expect to see a major increase in downloads this holiday season because many people have an eReader on their wish list,” said Library System Director Mary Jean Jakubowski. “We currently have more than 8000 downloadable eBooks of all genres, fiction, non-fiction, new as well as classic. Borrowers can electronically browse the catalog of eBooks by type - romance, mystery, health, etc. or search through our virtual stacks to make their selection.”

Once one has selected which item(s) to download, with internet or Wi-Fi access, the process can take less than five minutes through the Library System website’s Overdrive link <http://bit.ly/tc1Wan>. Downloadable print items can be checked out for up to 14 days and items can be reserved to a wait list if they are unavailable. Downloadable music stays on your system forever.

The Library System has more than 3 million print books available for borrowing through the 37-branch system. Free library card applications can be downloaded and taken to any of the local public libraries for processing. A valid form of identification and proof of address is necessary. Those under 17 years of age must be accompanied by a parent/guardian to obtain a card and the guardian is required to have valid identification.
