## **Birth Announcements in Newspapers**

Scan the *Buffalo (Evening)* News and the *Courier-Express* for a few weeks after the date of birth, and the *Buffalo Daily Law Journal*. No known index of local newspaper birth notices.

The Vital Records Office in Buffalo City Hall stopped releasing baby names to newspapers in 2006.

<u>Adoptions</u>: Unfortunately, birth notices are a poor source for adoption researchers, as the names of babies intended for adoption were not released to newspapers.

### **Marriage Announcements in Newspapers**

There is no comprehensive index of local newspaper wedding announcements. Browse the *Buffalo (Evening) News, Courier-Express,* and the *Buffalo Daily Law Journal* for a few weeks around the date of the wedding. In some years, announcements were published every day, scattered throughout the paper. A brief notice of marriage license may be found in some years.

<b>Erie County Poorhouse Deaths</b> The Erie County Poorhouse of Buffalo, NY and succeeding institutions known as the Erie County Alms House, Erie County Hospital, and Erie County Home & Infirmary (Alden, NY), operated as a social safety net for the region's poor and infirm. The collection consists of ledgers recording children "bound out"/adopted (1863-1868), intake registers (children 1829-1841-1852, adults/families 1829- 1845, 1861-1864, 1871-1889, 1908-1923), and hospital and death registers (1854-1867,1897-1952). <b>Deaths may be noted in all ledgers</b> . ### The NYC Historical Vital Records Project

Free online images of births (1866-1909), deaths (1862-1948), and marriages (1866-1937) are online through the NYC Department of Records and Information Services (DORIS) at <u>https://a860-historicalvitalrecords.nyc.gov/</u>. Coverage varies by borough and the project is ongoing, so more records will be added over time. The site is easiest to search if you know the year, certificate number, and borough where the vital event took place. That information can be found in the *Ancestry Library Edition* and *FamilySearch* databases listed below.

## **General Vital Records**

#### **Social Security Databases**

- Social Security Death Index, 1935-2014 [ALE, FS]
- Social Security Applications and Claims Index, 1936-2007 [ALE]

Both databases list birthdate and at least the month and year of death. The claims index also lists parents' names and places of birth. The bulk range of death dates are 1965-2014 years ago. Every person who had a social security number was not necessarily included.
