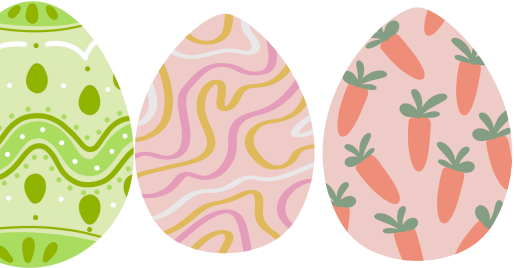

April 2, 16, 23

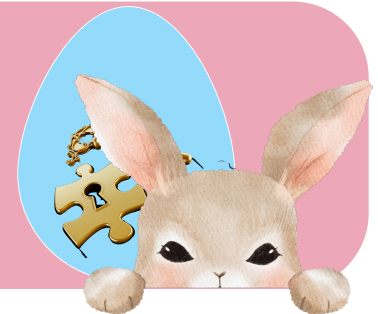

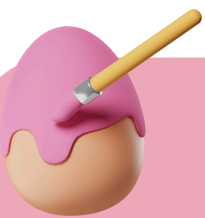
#### Makery

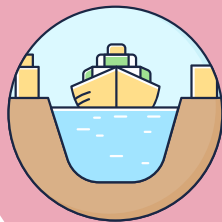

### History of Buffalo Series: Erie Canal

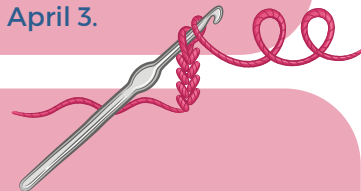

Earth Day is the perfect day to learn about how to support nature through gardening. You will learn easy methods to help pollinators, birds, nature and, improve your gardening.

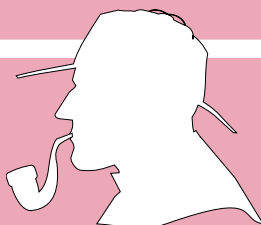
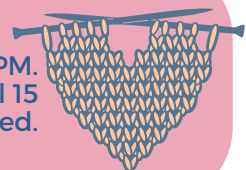

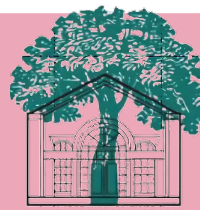
