A Study in Sherlock

For our February installment of *A Study in Sherlock*, we will be reading the short story *The Problem of Thor Bridge*, first published in 1922 in *The Strand Magazine* (U.K.) and *Hearst's International* (U.S.). This is the 51st Sherlock Holmes story and was collected in *The Case-Book of Sherlock Holmes* (1927).

The story is notable within the Sherlock Holmes canon for the initial reference to a tin dispatch box, located within the vaults of the Cox and Co. Bank at Charing Cross in London where Dr. Watson kept the papers concerning some of Holmes' unsolved or unfinished cases.

This story has been adapted multiple times for film and television. Following our discussion, we will be viewing the 1991 Granada TV version starring Jeremy Brett as Sherlock Holmes.
