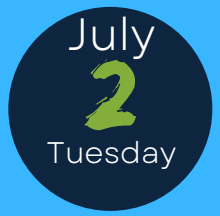
Explore&More Mini-golf

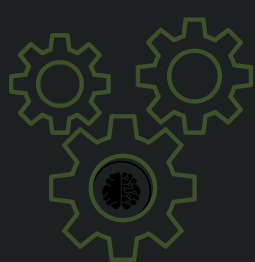

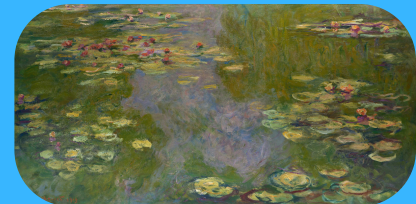

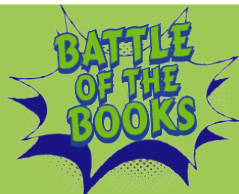
