"Friends of Libraries" Help Make Your Local Libraries Great!

Are you looking for a way to give back to the community? Do you want to get more involved with your local public library? A great way to do both is by joining a *Friends of the Library* volunteer organization, of which there are several affiliated with your Buffalo & Erie County Public Libraries. Many "*Friends*" groups are recruiting for new members right now.

Library "Friends" organizations help to make libraries stronger by providing financial, volunteer and advocacy support through assisting with various activities such as holding fundraisers, book sales and picnics, gathering prizes, purchasing programming materials, and selling refreshments during community events. "Friends" also help to promote public awareness and advocate for community and government support of library activities, resources and services.

In October 2021, the *Buffalo & Erie County Public Library Friends Council* was formed – representing 18 libraries and 17 *Friends* organizations. The Council is a member of the *New York Library Association's (NYLA) Task Force for Friends Councils*. Local members meet at least once annually (virtually or in-person) to share ideas, support, and discuss topics of mutual interest to benefit libraries.
