




2. Do you have a library card?




3. How often do you visit the library?




4. What do you visit the library for? (Check all that apply). 104 responses



5. When works best for you to attend library programs? (Check all that apply). 104 responses




6. Which day(s) of the week work(s) best for attending programs? (Check all that apply). 104 responses




7. What types of programs do you currently attend? (Check all that apply).






8. What types of programs would you be interested in attending? (Check all that apply). 104 responses




9. What is your favorite genre to read? (Check all that apply). 104 responses




