# **DIRECTOR'S REPORT:**

- Statistics Computer usage went down, but visitor counts went up at both Cheektowaga Libraries.
- **Programs** are abundant in the Cheektowaga Libraries.
  - 1. The Western New York Iris Society presented their annual Iris and Lily Show at JBR.
  - 2. A Puzzle Race was moderated by Librarian Jeff Matrachisia at REI. Participants were provided identical 200 piece puzzles and given 2 hours to race to completion.
  - 3. REI hosted a "Bike Repair and Bike Rodeo", partnering with GoBike Buffalo. The cost of the event was covered by Ralph Wilson grant funds.
  - 4. The Read to a Dog program sponsored by the SPCA's Paws for love brought joy to young readers at JBR.
  - 5. The Cheektowaga YES group has been moderating LEGO Clubs and Craft nights at both Cheektowaga Libraries.
  - 6. REI hosted a "Just Say Yes to Fruits and Vegetables" workshop. Nutritionist, Angie Braun reviewed wellness techniques and everyday cooking recipes.
  - 7. Homeschool Students participated in a 10 week course offered by Forty Two Photo LLC. JBR was the site for their gallery exhibit to share their work with friends and family.
  - 8. "Hooks, Needles, & Thread" meets at JBR on Thursdays from 12pm-2pm. They get together and work on any knitting project you are working on.
  - 9. The Clarity Group hosted a free Medicare 101 class at JBR.
  - 10. Librarian Jeff Matrachisia organized a STEM program focusing on Air & Water at REI. The program had demonstrations and hands on activities for the attendees.
- <u>Outreach</u> Director, Dan Caufield led a Small Business Development workshop at the Caspian Building on Genesee Street. He partnered with SCORE/Buffalo Niagara. Dan introduced the many free resources that the Library has to offer aspiring entrepreneurs.
- <u>Collections</u> Library staff continue to weed and order for their respective collections.
- Operations and Infrastructure Summer maintenance continues at both libraries.
- Partnerships, Meetings / Future Planning / Special Projects
  - 1. Director, Dan Caufield met with Jacob Rachwell to conduct an audit at both Cheektowaga Libraries. Both Libraries met all standards set by ADA.

- 2. Librarians Laura Scott and Jeff Matrachisia partnered with Collectlife to set a schedule for both libraries to host a blood donor event on July 8.
- 3. Director, Dan Caufield and the Department of Labor are hosting another Job Fair at JBR on September 18, 2024.
- 4. The Cheektowaga Libraries received a check for \$25.00 from Kara Jagodzinski, the Treasurer of the National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution, Abigail Filmore Chapter.
